

Important information – FIM Superbike World Championship

Autódromo Internacional do Algarve – from the 28th to the 30th of March

Accesses, transportation and parking

Arrive at the Autódromo Internacional do Algarve well in advance. Also count on the time to look for the car park, to look for a parking space and to walk to your stand and seat. The Autódromo Internacional do Algarve has prepared several uncovered car parks for you to park your car or motorcycle. Consult the attached map to identify the car park closest to your stand.

The parks are between 10 and 30 minutes' walk from the circuit, so we advise you to choose the park closest to your stand area so that this time is not increased.

Access and parking for cars and motorcycles is free, so you don't need to buy a badge. We remind you that there is no organized transport to the Circuit, so access must be made by car, motorcycle or other private vehicle, parking in the parks available around the venue according to the map.

There is no organized transport from the car park to the Stand areas, nor is there a transport system that runs through the doors of the Circuit.

Schedule

Opening of the stand doors, VIP Tower and Paddock Access Tunnel: 08:00am on the 3 days of the event.

Reduced Mobility

If you have purchased a ticket at the Main Stand and have a Reduced Mobility parking badge, you have a parking space reserved for people with reduced mobility.

There is no access for Reduced Mobility in the other stands, for safety reasons, namely in case of need for evacuation.



Stands and Access Doors

Please consult the attached map to locate the stands and access doors. The working system allows the following access:

- North, Lagos, Portimão and Portimão 2 stands: Door 4;
- Upper and Lower Main Grandstand: Door M;
- Paddock: access through the tunnel (south of the AIA Store)

Reduced Mobility tickets only give access to the Main Stand (Door M).

Paddock and VIP Tower Tickets can be accessed through all the previously mentioned doors (Tunnel, Gate M and Gate 4).

CONSUMPTION, IMAGE COLLECTION AND OTHER RULES

Consult the details of these and other rules on your ticket.

At the doors of the Circuit, the security staff will process the entrances by identifying the tickets electronically with barcode readers. The barcodes will have the information previously provided to the organization when purchasing the tickets, so spectators must be accompanied by their personal identification at the entrance to the circuit. After entering the circuit, there is signage to help the spectator reach their stand and allocated seat, as well as Staff to control the flow.

If you do not respect the instructions of the Staff, or are visibly under the influence of illicit substances, alcohol or demonstrate inappropriate behavior that puts the well-being and safety of the event and other spectators at risk, you may be asked to leave the venue, with no right to a refund of the ticket price.

The WSBK organization does not allow the professional capture of images, so it is not allowed to enter with camera/video cameras with a lens (fixed or removable) larger than 200mm or any video and sound image recorders, which are not for private use and purpose, or tripods.

You can take your helmet with you to the stands. There is no official place for the storage of helmets. There is no place to store or keep equipment, so you should not bring it with you or, if you do, it will be your responsibility to ensure its safekeeping and security.

It is only allowed the entrance of small and individual recipients, such as a bag, backpack or purse/wallet.

By imposition of the authorities and as in other types of sporting and recreational events (football matches and stadiums, for example), the entry of food and/or drinks into the Circuit is controlled. Only food products and beverages in quantity for individual consumption (a bottle, sandwiches, piece of fruit, snack, for example) can enter. The authorities, for security reasons, may give instructions for the bottles to enter without a cap.

There are several places to buy food and drinks at the stands. For logistical reasons, it is impossible to have, in all the stands, all the diversity of food on offer of the Circuit in the same way in all the stands, but there will be several alternatives in all the stands.

ENTRY OF MINORS

According to current Portuguese legislation, access to children under 3 years old is not allowed. The Autódromo Internacional do Algarve, together with some partners, decided to allow free access to all children under 16 years of age. Access is free upon purchasing a ticket with a 100% discount. Each adult with a valid ticket may be accompanied by a child.

An identification document may be requested at the entrance of the circuit by security to prove age.

Without an ID, a valid child ticket and without being accompanied by an adult with a valid ticket, entry to the circuit will not be allowed.

Activities and Paddock Access

From 4:30pm, on Friday (28th of March), and from 5pm, on Saturday (29th of March) and Sunday (30th of March), access to the paddock will be allowed to all spectators.

- **PARADE LAP**

Be part of an epic moment and join us on two laps around the incredible Autódromo Internacional do Algarve track. Bring your motorcycle and your favorite passenger and enjoy the Parade Lap at low speed, contemplating all the details of this memorable track. (Motorcycles from 50cc, the use of a helmet is mandatory).

Days: Saturday and Sunday

Time: 4:30pm – 4:45pm

Access: You must present yourself at the entrance to the Paddock tunnel, already equipped and on your motorcycle, at 4:15 pm.

You must be accompanied by your access, so that you can be checked and recorded by the security who will carry out the control.

The Parade Lap will take place in a controlled manner and in compliance with the safety rules indicated by the organization and staff present.

- **PIT WALK**

If you have a ticket with access to the Pit WALK, you must go to the entrance of the pit lane, on the south side, near the Self Restaurant (in the Paddock), next to the pool, 10 minutes in advance. The pit lane schedule, for Saturday and Sunday, is indicated in the official time of the event.

For the access bracelets to be given to you, you must present your ticket to the security guards and staff who will carry the control.

Backpacks or bags, open shoes, drinks and food are not allowed to enter the Pit Walk. The organization (DORNA) may change or cancel the Pit Walk without prior notice, and the Autódromo do Algarve is unaware of this decision.

SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES

We are implementing initiatives to promote biodiversity, reduce the carbon footprint and improve sustainability. These initiatives include the use of solar energy, the implementation of electronic ticketing, to minimize the use of paper, among others.

- Cashless payments – We will provide specific places to purchase your wristband, so that all payments in the various food spaces, inside the circuit, are made only through electronic payments.
- Reusable cups – We will make available, upon a symbolic payment of €1, a personalized AIA and reusable cup. It can be returned to the designed place, according to the conditions presented on site.
